**NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE OF INDIANA IMMUNIZATION
REQUIREMENTS AS OF SCHOOL YEAR 2010-2011**

We have received this information from the Indiana State Department of Health regarding additions to the already required immunizations:

“Students entering grades 6-12 must have appropriate documentation of the following vaccinations:

- TDAP (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Acellular Pertussis vaccine)
- MENACTRA (Meningococcal conjugate vaccine)
- 2 VARIVAX (chickenpox vaccine) or documentation of disease history

Vaccines may be given at a local board of health or by the student’s physician. Documented proof of immunization must be provided to the school nurse before the start of the 2011-2012 school year. We recommend that parents attend to these new requirements now to avoid long lines and delays at the health department or physician offices.
