Tuition charges include daily milk and textbooks but exclude the registration fee. Tuition covers approximately 96% of the cost of education. The balance is raised through fundraising efforts, church offerings and association members' donations. Tuition is billed over 12 months beginning June 1.

How can I reduce tuition? CPCS realizes that many families sacrifice a great deal to send their child(ren) to CPCS. Although scholarships are not available, we do offer two different opportunities to lower your tuition. Please read on to learn more!

Second Life Resale Shoppe

Second Life Resale Shoppe is an organization that operates for the benefit of all families sending their children to CPCS. The Second Life Resale Shoppe, located in Crown Point, Indiana, opened its doors for business in March 2010. The main reason the store began is expressed in the mission of the store: *“To raise funds for CPCS by selling tax-deductible donations provided by generous people from the surrounding community. Through the work at Second Life Resale Shoppe we seek to make a difference in God’s kingdom.”*

The store is operated by a separate Board of Directors who oversee the daily operation of the store. **In its first year the Second Life Resale Board gave CPCS a collective gift of \$125,000 to assist parents with their tuition.** Gifts will continue and are reflected as a credit on every student’s tuition statement.

We are excited about Second Life and the benefit for each one of our families. The success of the store depends heavily on donations received and the number of volunteers who graciously give their time and talents to help the store realize its full potential. **Each parent is strongly encouraged to donate three—four hours each month as a volunteer in the store. We view this organization as a corporate endeavor that will benefit each parent with a tuition credit thus lowering your tuition.** More information can be found at secondliferesale.com.



Scrip

Scrip is a tuition reduction program which can be started at anytime. Credit that is earned prior to your child’s enrollment at CPCS will be held in your family’s tuition account until they are enrolled.

This is how the program works: **Scrip gift cards or certificates are ordered** from an order sheet (hard copy or online) at face value. These are for items that you purchase in your normal walk of life (groceries, fuel, clothing, restaurants, gifts, etc.) and they are “same as cash” at the retailer. The school purchases these gift cards at a discount.

The difference between what you pay and what the school pays is the profit and it is credited to your tuition account. Along with each order, you are given a notice of the net profit to your account. Your net profit is applied to your tuition account three times per year, at which time it will show on your statement as a credit or you will receive a notice of the accumulated credit. This truly is a program that has great potential for tuition reduction. More information can be found at crownpointchristian.org.
