

Second Life Resale Classroom Sort Nights

What is the purpose/goal of these nights?

Classroom sorts are a way for Second Life to encourage the relationships with CPCS families while helping to process the inventory at Second Life Resale. These hours can be part of a family's 3-4 hours that are requested per month by the Store Board.

When do they happen?

Every Thursday night Second Life Resale is open to the public until 7:00 pm. Sort night will go until 10:00 pm. This allows you to come in at any time that suits your schedule.

Every Thursday night there will be grades that are scheduled to come to sort items, hang items, clean items, clean the store, stock the store, and continually prepare the store for business. The room moms will be sending you a reminder for your class sort night.

Who is to attend?

A parent of the child in the class listed for a specific Thursday, is asked to represent the family that night. This will allow them to get to know more parents of children in their child's class. Of course, we will always welcome any grandparent or parent to help when your available, even if you don't have a child in a grade listed on the schedule.

Due to the level of work, safety issues, and hopes of a larger volunteer base on Thursday evenings, Middle School aged children are welcome to attend **WITH** their parent. We ask that children younger than Middle School not attend for safety reasons.
