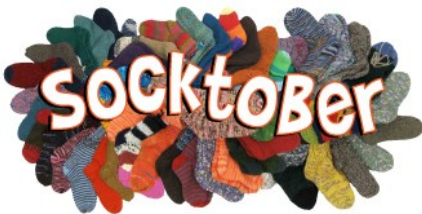
Eighth Grade Class Goes on a Retreat
